Brazil

- Brazil is the fifth largest country in the world, with an area of 8 515 767.049 km².
- Brazil is the seventh most populous country in the world, adding up to 203 080 756 residents, according to the 2022 Population Census.
- The value of the GDP in 2024 was R\$11.7 trillion, a growth of 3.4% in relation to the previous year. The *per capita* GDP in that same year was R\$55,247.45.
- In Brazil, the Amazônia Biome covers an area of approximately 4.19 million km², occupying nearly 49.29% of the national territory.

Bahia

- The state of Bahia is known as the “cradle of Brazil”, as it was the arrival place of the Portuguese in the year 1500.
- Bahia has a rich cultural and religious diversity, with a strong African influence, which is present in its cuisine, music and religiosity.
- Geographically, Bahia has the largest coastline in Brazil and the largest artificial lake in the world, Sobradinho.
